We will continue to work on subtraction in math. Students have started regrouping and have done very well. This week we will get into regrouping more than once in a problem and use larger numbers. Please continue to practice basic addition and subtraction math facts daily with your child.

We will continue learning about ecosystems this week in science and find out what animals and plants live in each. We will discuss how living and nonliving things depend on one another.

We will finish our Seasons of the Church year booklet. We will also learn more about Ordinary Time as we do that.

We will continue learning about verbs in English.

We will be reading a folktale this week called *Martina the Beautiful Cockroach*. Along with this story, we will work on visualizing the story using vivid details, problem and solution, and synonyms. Students will take the selection test over this story on Thursday, after they have had several opportunities to read it.

Beginning this week, we will be using a classroom economy. This ties in with one of our units in social studies. We will discuss the details in our class meeting.
